Have your photo taken reading your favorite book to Pickles, the alligator. Those who have photos made can enter into a drawing for a free book.

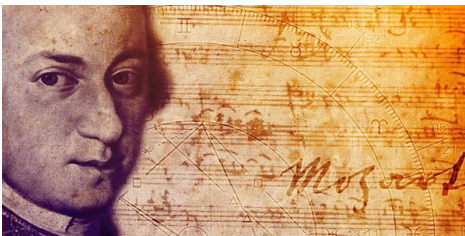
