March 7, 14, 21, & 28

Toddler Time @ 10:00 AM

For children from walking through 2 years old. Sessions are very informal and include short books, simple rhymes, songs, and fingerplays. Children must be accompanied by an adult.

Sessions last 20 to 25 minutes.

Lapsit @ 10:30 AM

For babies from birth through crawling. Sessions are very informal and include board books, simple rhymes, songs, and fingerplays.

Sessions last 15 to 20 minutes.

Preschool @ 10:30 AM

For children 3 to 5 years old. Sessions are more structured and include books, rhymes, and songs. Sessions last 25-30 minutes.

All children under the age of 9 must be accompanied by an adult.

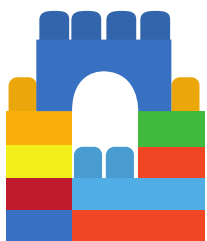


Friday, March 3, 9:00 AM to 11:00 AM
