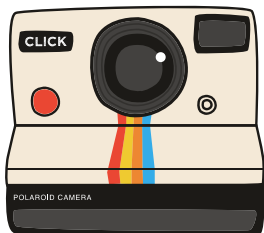
MOZART AND ME
