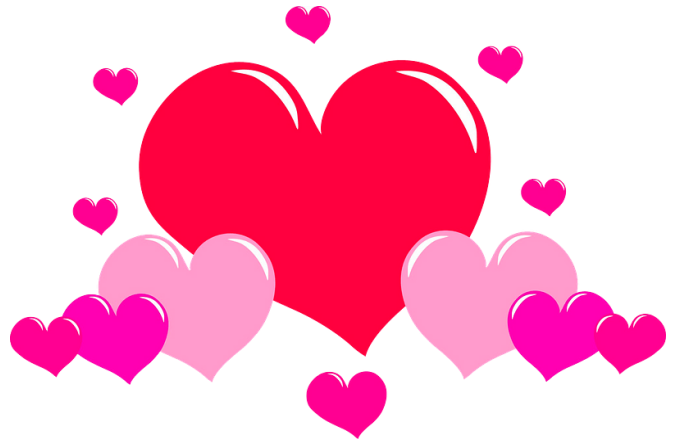

**Wednesday, February 14 @ 9:00 AM—6:00 PM**

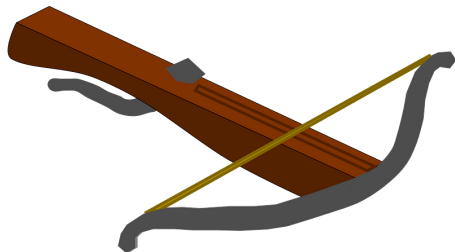
