

*Q: What does the Career Center offer?*

A: The Career Center strives to teach individuals to become their own career managers and make them more resilient to career setbacks and layoffs. The tools we employ are: one-on-one sessions with a certified career coach, seminars, assessments and use of databases and pertinent literature.

*Q: What is a coaching session like?*

A: It depends on the individual's need. Mostly we work on figuring out "what to do when I grow up?" -- creating and improving resumés and cover letters, job searching strategies, preparing for interviews and walking through online applications.

*Q: Is there a fee for coaching sessions?*

A: No! It's FREE!

*Q: Do I need an appointment for a coaching session?*

A: Yes, please call (225) 231-3733 and make an appointment.

*Q: Does the Career Center accept applications?*

A: No. We are not an employment agency. We post job openings that are sent to us in the Career Center Office itself and also online at [www.careercenterbr.com](http://www.careercenterbr.com), but the individual is responsible for the application process.

*Q: Do you write resumés?*

A: We will work with you on creating and/or improving your resumé, and you can use the Career Center computers to write it. However, we will not type or write it for you!

*Q: Will you complete online applications?*

A: While we will not fill out your online application, you can complete online applications using the Career Center computers -- FREE.

We also will coach you through the process. WiFi is FREE, as well.

*Q: What kinds of seminars do you offer?*

A: Seminars cover diverse career and workplace topics. Previous seminar topics have included: careers in sales and healthcare, state and local government jobs and how to deal with career setbacks.
