- 6) The following work is being installed:
 - a. Zinc wall panels
 - b. Curtainwall
 - c. Exterior gypsum board sheathing
 - d. Metal studs
 - e. Air barrier
 - f. Sprinkler system piping
 - g. Interior gypsum board.
