

Paper Flower Pencil



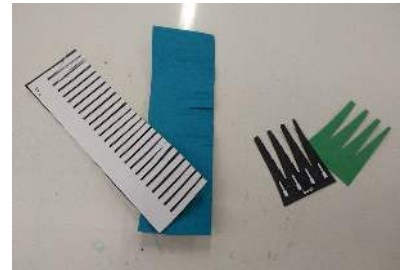
April showers bring May flowers.

If you aren't finding flowers outside yet, you can make some simple paper flowers to decorate your favorite pencil.

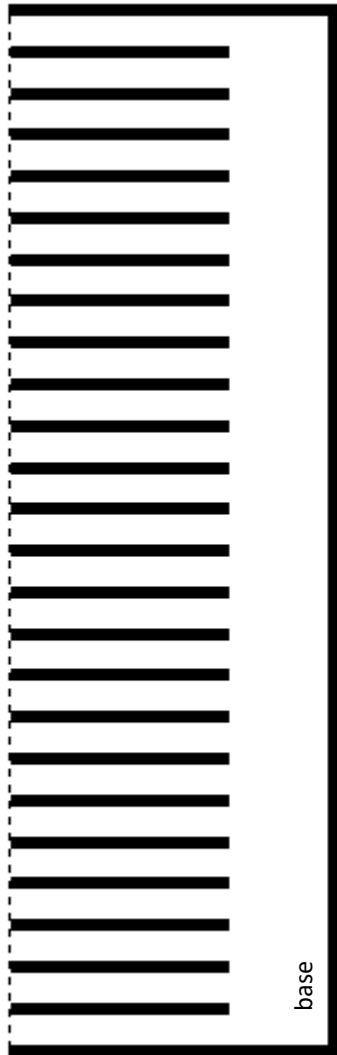
You will find a template for a simple wrap paper flower attached.

Cut out the template and trace on colorful paper. Cut out the flowers and put a thin line of glue at the bottom of the flower paper. Shift the top layer up to make puffy petals. Then wrap the glue covered petals around the end of a pencil. Follow up by adding the leaves the same way!

When it is dry, enjoy a beautiful flower pencil!



Paper Flower Template



FLOWER TEMPLATE:

- Cut out template
- Pick a flower colored paper and fold in half.
- Place template on folded edge of paper as indicated and cut out rectangle.
- Keep paper folded and cut from fold inward along dark lines.
- Open paper slightly and place a line of glue along the bottom of the cuts on the bottom piece of paper.
- Lay the top paper over the glue, leaving half of the base of the bottom paper exposed.



(like this)

- Be careful not to squish it flat. Let dry.
- Place a line of glue along the bottom of the base and wrap around a pencil. These are your flower petals!

Place this edge on the folded edge of the paper. Be careful not to cut the folds.

LEAF TEMPLATE

- Cut out leaf template.
- Trace on green paper.
- Place a line of glue along the base of the leaves and wrap around the base of your flower on your pencil.
- Let dry and enjoy your wrap paper flower pencil!
