Ripped Paper Rainbow

When it rains, you might see a rainbow.

Make a rainbow you can keep even on sunny days with some colorful paper, glue, and cotton balls.

You will find a simple rainbow template attached.

Cut out the template. Rip colored paper into tiny squares and sort by color. Starting at the top of the rainbow, put a thin line along the top of the arc. Pick a color and line up the squares on the line of glue. Add another line of glue under the first color arc and repeat with another color. Continue until your rainbow is covered in color.



To make the clouds nice and fluffy, pull cotton balls apart to fluff. Cover the cloud shape in glue and press the fluff gently into the glue. Wait for the glue to dry, then display!
