# Weather Journal



Scientists can learn a lot from past and present records of the weather! They look at what has changed, what was rare or common, and what the averages were.

You can make your own weather journal and see what you notice with this simple craft!

## SUPPLIES:

- writing paper
- construction paper
- stapler
- pencil or pen

## INSTRUCTIONS:

Step 1: Fold construction paper and copy or notebook paper in half (hamburger style). When you fold the copy/notebook paper in half, fold it all at once in one large stack.

Step 2: Place the copy/notebook paper inside of the construction paper and staple along the closed edges of the construction paper.

Step 3: Write down days of the week on each page of the copy/notebook paper. This is where you will keep track of the weather each day.

Step 4: Decorate the covers of your journal however you like!
