PARACHUTE PLAY

SUPPLIES: -string -paper

-paper cup -decorating supplies -hole punch

Directions:

-garbage bag

• Cut an 18-inch circle from the plastic garbage bag

-scissors

- Punch 8 holes around the circle approximately one inch from the edge
- Tie a length of string through each hole and secure with a knot.
- Decorate the paper cup with stickers, markers, or crayons, then punch two holes in the cup sides.
- Tie the ends of four parachute strings through each hole in the cup
- Tightly close the parachute like an umbrella, then fold in half and place loosely inside of the cup with folded end up.
- Throw the parachute as high as you can, but be sure to stay away from power lines.



BONUS CHALLENGE: After trying your parachute several times, stop and reflect. Can you improve your parachute? What might you change so your parachute could safely carry a small package or doll?
