Snowstorm In A Bottle



SUPPLIES:

-clear bottle -water -corn syrup -baby oil -glitter and sequins -duck tape

DIRECTIONS:

- Fill 1/4 bottle with corn syrup.
- Fill the bottle up to half with baby oil.
- Fill the bottle up to 3/4 with water.
- Add as much glitter and sequins as you would like!
- Fill the bottle to the top with water.
- Make sure the lid is closed securely.
- To be extra sure the lid stays shut, tape over it with duck tape.
- Shake the bottle around to create your own snowstorm!

THINKING FURTHER:

- How long does it take until the snow drifts to the bottom?
- Do different size glitter pieces fall differently?
- Can you pick out a single snowflake and watch it until it settles?
- What else could you add to the bottle to change the composition?
