Scientists use graphs and surveys to help make data they collect easier to interpret so they can solve mysteries.

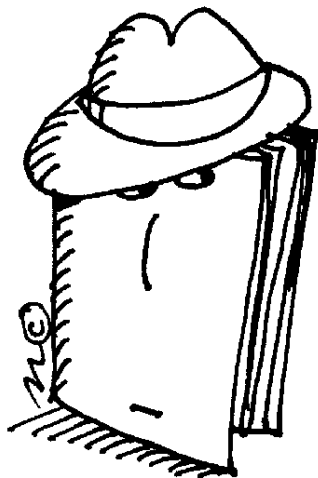
Solve the mystery of the favorite book sleuth by taking a poll of your friends and family and then graphing it on the graph!
