SUPPLIES for CRAFT

2 Coffee Filters Water-based Markers

1 Pipe Cleaner Small Spray Bottle



Decorate each coffee filter with the markers in a specific pattern or random coloring. Spray the filters lightly with water allowing the colors to run together in a tie-dye design.

When the filters are dry, pinch together each one in the middle to form upper and lower wings for the butterfly. Twist the pipe cleaner to hold the wings together. Curl the ends of the pipe cleaner to form antennae shapes for your butterfly.
