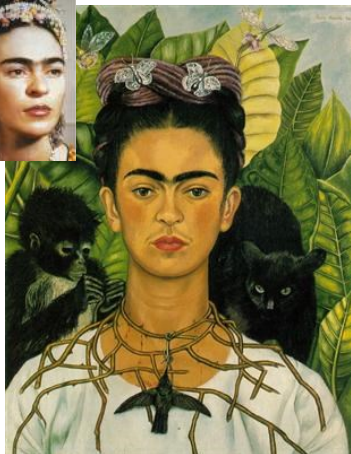
King Alphonso (1983)

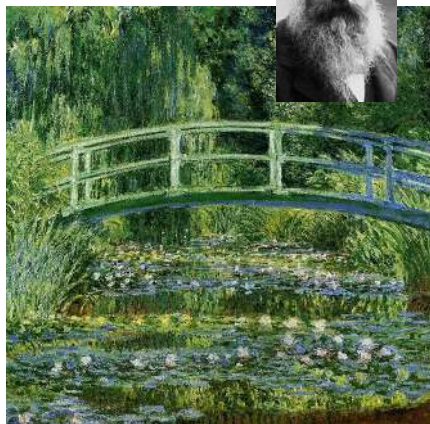
Forest, British Columbia

by Claude Monet, from Paris, France

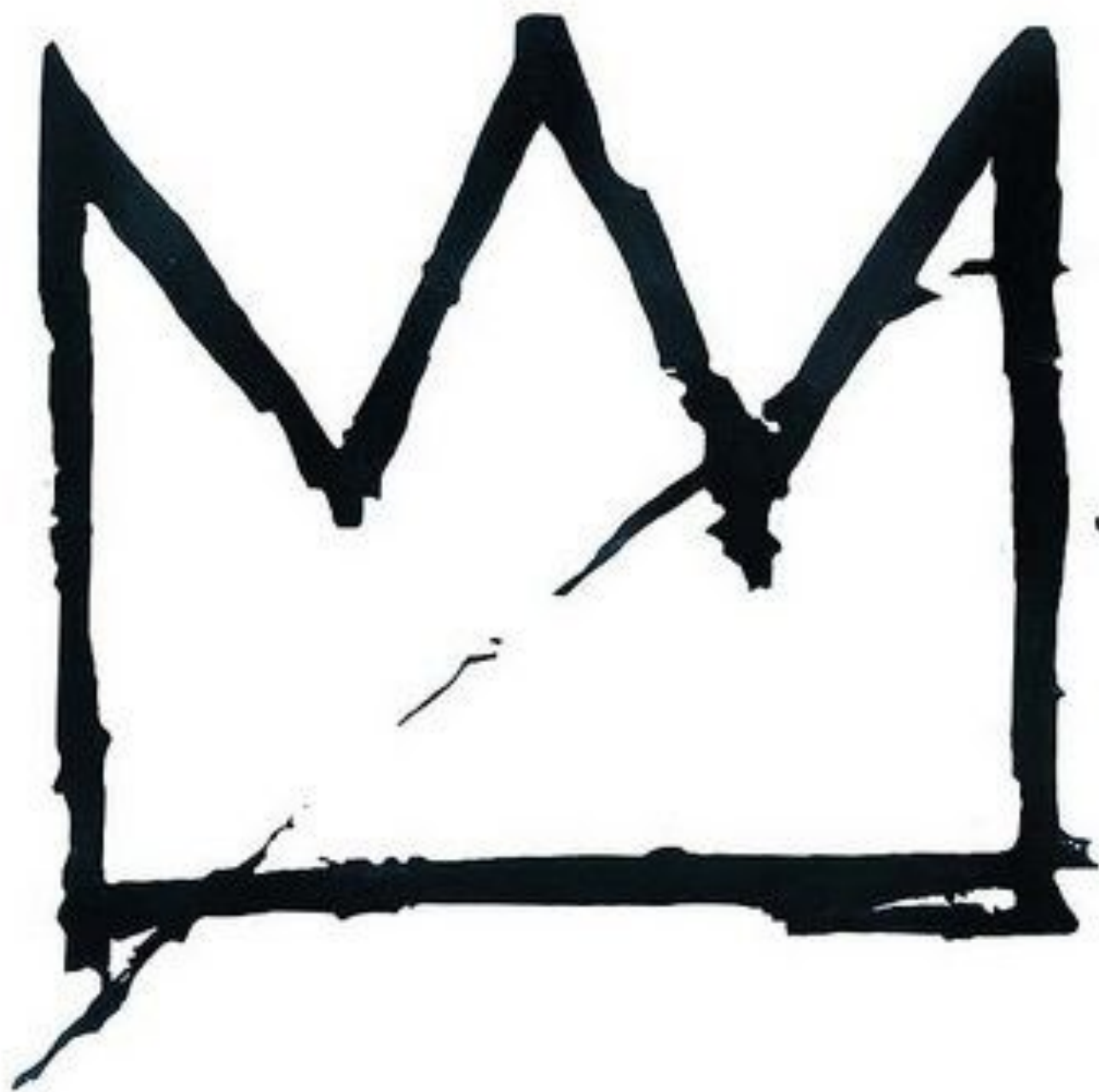


The Starry Night (1889)

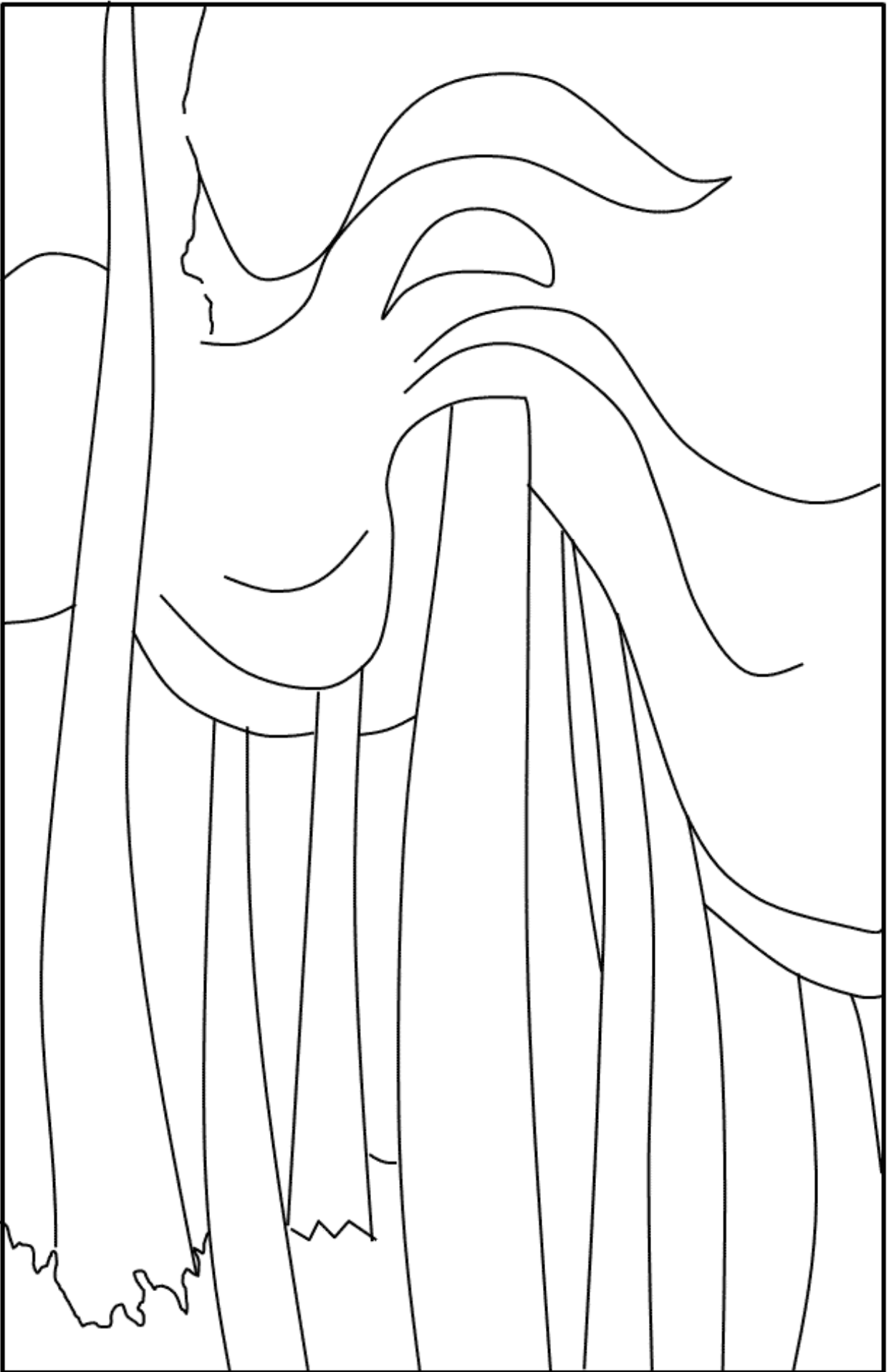

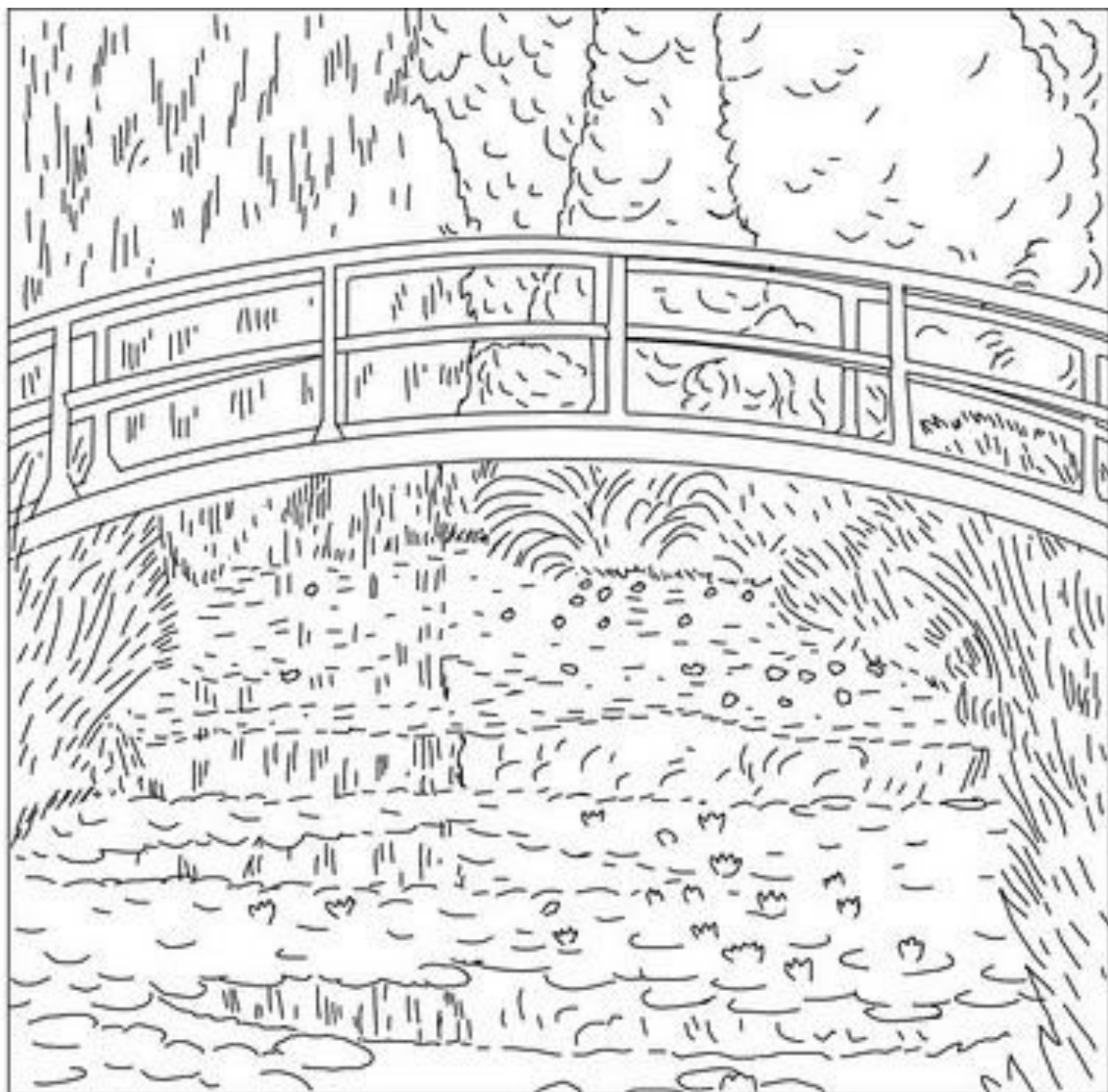
