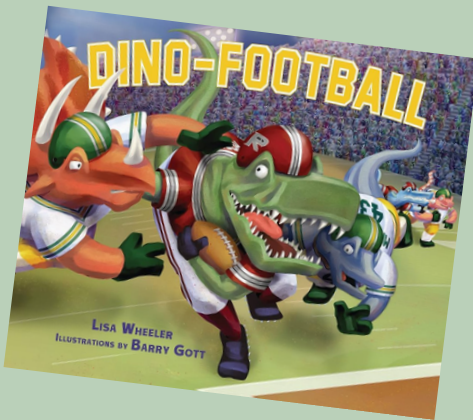

OBOC DINO-FOOTBALL STORYCRAFT

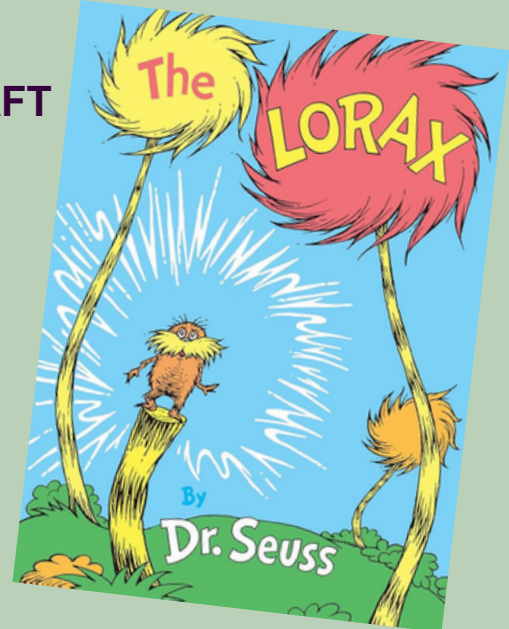
APRIL 10 THURSDAY @ 4 PM

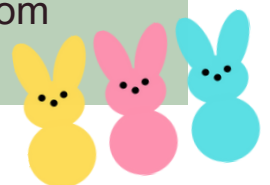
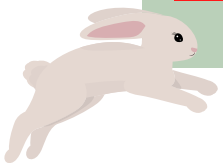
