Tuesday, April 8–Friday, April 11, 9:30 AM–5:30 PM, Ages 3-11

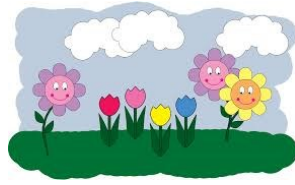
Join us in the Greenwell Springs Branch Library to make a Love My Library snail during National Library Week while supplies last.
