### Toddler Time @ 10:00 AM

For children from walking through 2 years old. Sessions are informal and include short books, simple rhymes, songs, and fingerplays. Sessions last 20 to 25 minutes.



### **Lapsit @ 10:30 AM**

For babies from birth through crawling. Sessions are very informal and include board books, simple rhymes, songs, and fingerplays. Sessions last 15 to 20 minutes.



#### Preschool @ 10:30 AM

For children 3 to 5 years old. Sessions are more structured and include books, rhymes, and songs. Sessions last 25-30 minutes.

## Friday, April 4, 9:00 AM to 11:00 AM SENSORY SENSITIVITY TIME AT THE LIBRARY






## Mondays, April 7, 14, & 28, 6:30 PM, Ages 3-11 MANDARIN STORY TIME
