FUNDING:

- Using the Existing Site
- Phase II Total is \$8.8M; \$7,020,000 is budgeted for Construction
- The City-Parish is the Owner; the Library is the User
- City-Parish Architectural Services Staff will work with the Architect and the General Contractor to oversee the Project
- Funds for this Pay-As-You-Go Project were amassed by the East Baton Rouge Parish Library over time, with no bonds or indebtedness; All Financed through the Library's 10-year Dedicated Property Tax and in Accordance with the Capital Improvement Plan
