**Thursday, August 14 at 4:30 PM (Age: 8-11)**

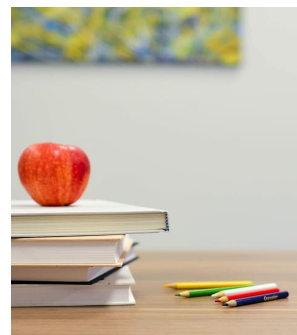
